Background to the ICTR

As was the case with the establishment of the ICTY, the conflict in Rwanda also had deep cultural and ethnic roots.

The population of Rwanda was comprised of a Hutu Majority, and the Tutsi and Twa minority groups.

The Tutsi ethnic group had come to have a privileged status in society, partially due to the impact of colonialism.

The tensions between the Hutu and the Tutsi ethnic groups increased during the collapse of colonial rule.

- ▶ During a period of 100 days, a genocide took place with the mass slaughtering of the Tutsi and moderate Hutu population.
- ▶ The genocide was notable due to the number of deaths, the concentration of deaths and the extensive use of genocidal rape and sexual abuse.
